

Recent Police Activity

Blotter updates may be absent for various reasons, including time constraints.

1/18/12 – A 37 year old female from Walden, NY, was arrested shortly after she was involved in a 2 car motor vehicle accident in Valhalla. The female was charged with driving with a suspended license, processed and released on bail.

1/15/12 – A twenty year old man from Mamaroneck was observed by patrol in Hawthorne acting in a suspicious manner while inside his vehicle. The man was later arrested for driving with a suspended license, possession of heroin and possession of a hypodermic needle.

1/13/12 – An eighteen year old male, from Pleasantville, was arrested after police located him in an unconscious state on Route 9A, Hawthorne, after he had injected himself with heroine.

1/12/12 – A forcible daytime burglary occurred on Halsey Pl., Valhalla. Once inside the home the subject(s) ransacked the master bedroom.

1/11/12 – A 41 year old Valhalla man was arrested after a short investigation and charged with criminal possession of a weapon (loaded hand gun). While in a holding room at police headquarters the defendant attempted to break a glass window, and while doing so damaged a wooden door. The man was additionally charged with felony criminal mischief. He was arraigned and remanded to the Westchester County Jail without bail.

1/6/12 – Police arrested a White Plains man after patrol observed the driver of a blue van acting suspiciously in Hawthorne. Upon further investigation, a counterfeit NYS Inspection sticker was found to be displayed on the vehicle. The man was arrested and charged with a misdemeanor.

1/5/12 – A 19 year old Poughkeepsie man was arrested for driving with a suspended license after someone reported a suspicious vehicle in the area of Rolling Hills Rd, Thornwood. The man was later released on bail.

1/1/12 – Police arrested a Bronx man and a Mount Kisco woman for grand larceny after they broke into a parked car in the Sleepy Hollow area of Mount Pleasant. During the follow up

investigation it was determined that the couple was responsible for car larcenies in Briarcliff, Sleepy Hollow, Yorktown, New Castle and Pleasantville. Further charges are expected.

12/31/11 – Police arrested a Valhalla and a Pleasantville man for DWI during a New Years Eve road check. A Sleepy Hollow man was arrested for driving with a suspended license; he had 18 active suspensions on his license. Additionally, he was charged with possession of marihuana.
