

## Recent Police Activity

*Blotter updates may be absent for various reasons, including time constraints.*

07/15/10 – While on routine patrol at around 3:10 AM, an officer observed a motorist make an abrupt turn on Phelps Way, in the Sleepy Hollow area of Mt. Pleasant. A traffic stop was made, at which time it was discovered that the driver, Wilson E. Tello, 26, of Port Chester was intoxicated. Tello was charged with 2 counts of driving while intoxicated, held in the local lockup, and then later arraigned in the justice court.

7/13/10 – Ahmed Omar, 33, of Hawthorne was arrested for violating a criminal court order of protection by making a threatening phone call to a protected person. Omar was charged with criminal contempt, a misdemeanor. Omar was being held on \$5000 cash bail at the Westchester County Jail.

7/10/10 – Police responded to the report of a suspicious person in the Heritage Estates in Pleasantville. Police searched and located Daniel J. Chowanec, 21, of North White Plains. During their investigation several stolen items were located on his person. Chowanec was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property. He was arraigned and sent to the County Jail on \$750 cash bail.

7/9/10 – Clement K Osafo, 30, Bronx, was arrested for aggravated harassment after he allegedly made dozens of annoying phone calls to a resident in Pleasantville. Osafo was released without bail after a court arraignment. An Order of Protection was served upon Osafo.

7/6/10 – Police arrested Hector Orellana, 30, of Elmsford, around 4:40 PM, after it is alleged that Orellana has been stalking and harassing a female acquaintance. Orellana, an illegal immigrant from Guatemala, was charged with stalking, a felony, and aggravated harassment, a misdemeanor. Orellana was arraigned in Mt. Pleasant Justice Court and is currently being held on \$50,000 bond at the Westchester County Jail.

7/6/10 – At approximately 10:00 AM, patrol stopped a commercial vehicle on Saw Mill River Rd, in Hawthorne, for a traffic violation. The driver, Patricio Zhina, 41, of Ossining, was arrested for driving with a suspended license. He was processed and released on his own recognizance.

7/5/10 – At 3:35 AM, police responded to an auto accident on Bear Ridge Rd. When police arrived, they observed a 2004 BMW had crashed into a telephone pole. During the investigation it was determined that Greg Sabo, 19, of Bedford, NY, was intoxicated. He was arrested and charged with DWI and 2 counts of possession of a controlled substance for numerous pills located on his person. Sabo was held in the local lock-up due to his intoxication. He was later released to his father.

7/5/10 – Police stopped Fabian Castro, 30, of Mamaroneck, around 1:45AM, while he was driving on Broadway in Hawthorne. It was soon learned that Castro had six active suspensions on his driver's license. Castro was arrested and later released on \$200 cash bail.

07/04/10 – Andrew J. Wechter, 22, of Carmel, was stopped on Route 9A by patrol after he was seen operating his vehicle with a defective headlight. During that time it was discovered that Wechter's license was suspended for failure to answer a ticket in Fishkill. Wechter was processed and released on an appearance ticket.

7/4/10 - A Hawthorne man was arrested and charged with attempted assault after he struck a female during an argument. Milton R. Duarte-Lopez, 39, was arraigned in Mt. Pleasant Court and held on \$2500 cash bail.

07/02/10 – Two men were arrested after an alert pharmacist at CVS noticed a prescription form seemed out of the ordinary. Store employees called the Mt. Pleasant Police to report the incident. Police searched the area locating a vehicle with two occupants that fit the description given by store employees. Nicholas J. Omeally, 24, of NYC, was arrested and charged with possession of a forged instrument, the prescription. The second person in the vehicle, the driver, Suni O Wynter, 28, of the Bronx, was arrested and charged with driving with a suspended license. Omeally was remanded to the county jail without bail. Wynter was released on \$500 cash bail.

6/30/10 – A 42 year old male from Chappaqua, was arrested after police stopped his vehicle during a police investigation. During that time, the driver, Christopher O Johnson, was found to be in possession of a quantity of heroine. Johnson was eventually charged with criminal possession of a controlled substance, a misdemeanor, and possession of a controlled substance with intent to sell, a felony. Johnson was held in the local lockup pending arraignment.

6/30/10 – A 17 year old female from the Pleasantville Cottage School was arrested for felony criminal mischief after she intentionally damaged school property. The female was charged and later released back to the school.

6/29/10 – Anne E. Farley, 51, of Briarcliff, NY, was arrested after she was discovered by an off duty Mt. Pleasant Officer unconscious in her vehicle. A subsequent investigation revealed that Ms. Farley was intoxicated. She was taken to the hospital for treatment and later charged with DWI. She is scheduled to appear in court on 7/1/10.

6/28/10 – A 26 year old female from Bronx, NY was arrested for operating her motor vehicle while the registration was suspended. Marquita S. Williams, was charged and released without bail.

6/25/10 – A 16 year old female from the Hawthorne Cedar Knolls School was arrested and charged with criminal mischief after she allegedly destroyed school property. She was later released back to the school.

6/24/10 – Michael T. Linnane, 50, of Valhalla, was arrested after he allegedly violated the stay away provision of a court order. He was charged with criminal Contempt and sent to the Westchester County Jail on \$50,000 bail.

6/23/10 – After an intensive investigation, Mt. Pleasant Police arrested a male and female from Pleasantville, and charged both with armed robbery. The incident stemmed from the armed robbery of a female while she was at the ATM machine in the Thornwood Town Center days earlier. James J. Graziano, 24, and Tara Persaud, 19, were both charged with Robbery in the first degree. The investigation is continuing while both remain incarcerated at the Westchester County Jail.

6/22/10 – Police arrested an 18 year old from the Pleasantville Cottage School after he allegedly had sexual intercourse with a 13 year old female. He was charged with Rape in the second degree and is currently being held on \$25,000 bail.

6/21/10 – Police arrested a Pleasantville man during a search of his home which was authorized by Westchester County Probation. Leon Vataj, 40, was charged with criminal possession of a controlled substance and criminal possession of drug paraphernalia. He was arraigned and sent to the Westchester County Jail.

6/20/10 – Elmer R. Sandoval, an undocumented immigrant, residing in Hawthorne, was arrested and charged with the forcible rape of an adult female. He was arraigned and sent to the Westchester County Jail without bail.

6/20/10 – Michael C. Pietropaolo, 20, of Yonkers, was charged with petit larceny after he allegedly stole approximately \$330 while he was working at the Home Depot Store in Hawthorne. He was charged and later released on an appearance ticket.

6/20/10 – Jarad C. Delano, 21, of No. White Plains, was arrested and charged with criminal possession of a controlled substance after he was stopped for a motor vehicle violation in Thornwood. He was later released with a future court date.

This incident occurred on the property of the Hawthorne Cedar Knolls School. Mr. Cannady was arraigned in Mt. Pleasant Court and released without bail.
